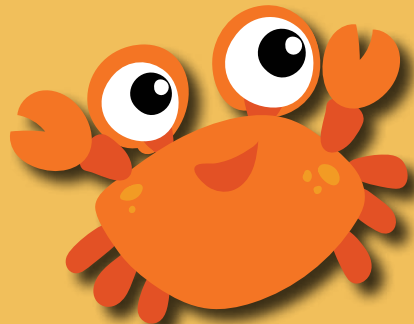


BIBLE PASSAGE Isaiah 40:28

The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom.

BIBLE SUMMARY

God unfolds His "Glorious Galaxy" by creating the heavens and the earth in five days and uses the sixth day to create animals on earth and man as His crowning achievement to have command over the whole earth. Unit 1 then highlights both the calling and empowerment of Abram as God's loyal servant.



Adventures in the Genesis of God's Creation and the Debut of God's Son

LESSON 1

GOD CREATES THE WORLD (GENESIS 1)

LESSON TARGET: Know that God created the heavens and the earth in six days.

LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 1, God speaks His Word to create the heavens and the earth from nothing through His eternal power and wisdom. He creates everything and it is very good, including the universe as a breathtaking backdrop for earth. He also creates the earth and fills it with life, even making man in His exact likeness. As His highest achievement, God creates man to fellowship with Him.



LESSON 2

GOD CREATES MAN (GENESIS 2)

LESSON TARGET: Understand that God created man and woman and placed them in the Garden of Eden.

LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 2, God blesses the seventh day as holy and rests after His work of creation. We then see the details of God forming man from the dust and giving Adam the breath of life, placing him in the Garden of Eden among the Tree of Life and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. God commands Adam not to eat from this tree and creates a suitable helper from his side and calls her woman.



LESSON 3

GOD CALLS ABRAM (GENESIS 12:1-9)

LESSON TARGET: Learn that God made a covenant with Abram to make him the father of a great nation.

LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 12, God calls Abram to leave his homeland with the promise of making a great nation and blessing all the families of the earth through him. Abram and his family leave Ur and sojourn in the land of Canaan, and then travel down into Egypt because of a great famine, where they are tested in Pharaoh's court when Abram claimed his wife Sarai was his sister in an attempt to protect her.



LESSON 4

GOD EMPOWERS ABRAM TO RESCUE LOT (GENESIS 14)

LESSON TARGET: Remember that God enabled Abram to rescue his nephew Lot.

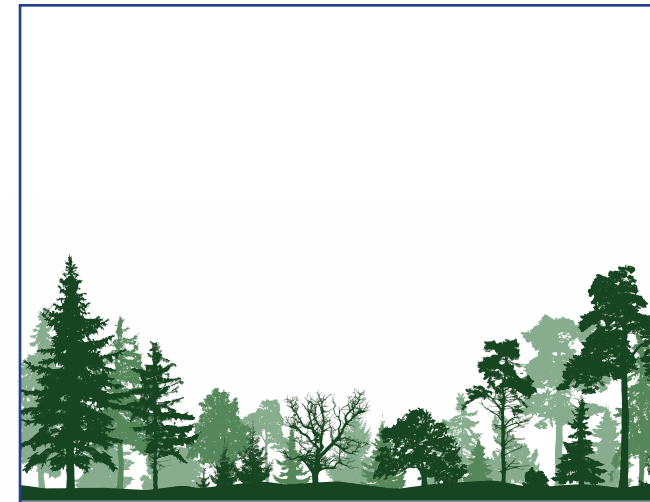
LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 14, God demonstrates His power to protect His people when Abram's nephew Lot, who lives in Sodom, is captured during the battle of the kings of Chedorlaomer in the valley of Siddim. The enemy kings take Lot and his goods, but one escapes and informs Abram, who then assembles his 318 trained men to strike the enemy armies and bring back Lot, the women and others, and the goods.

LESSON 1 CRAFT

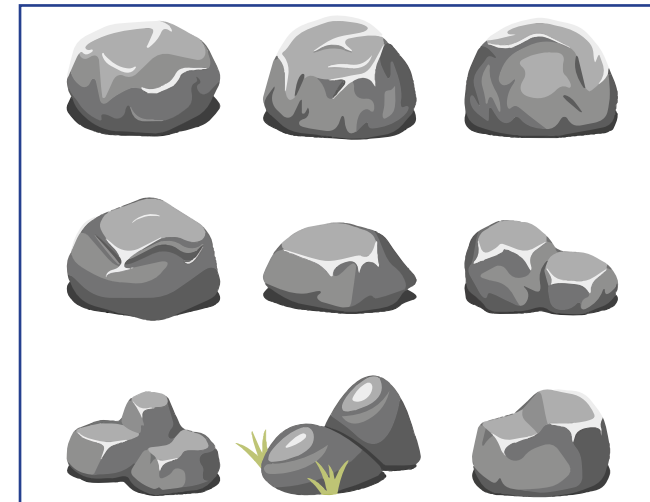


LESSON 3 CRAFT

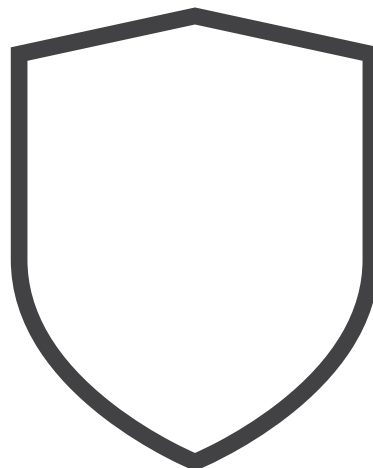


LESSON 4 CRAFT

DAY 1

Genesis 1

God creates the world in 6 days. In the beginning, before there was an earth, oceans, animals, or people, there was God. So God said, "Let there be light." God liked the light! He separated the light from the dark and called them day and night. On the second day, God separated the water on the ground, like oceans, from the water in the sky, like clouds and fog. On the third day, God separated the water from the dry land so that we could have rivers, beaches, and shores. God made plants that make seeds grow on the dry land, like apple trees, pansies, cacti, and wheat. On the fourth day, God put in the sky our bright, shining sun for daytime and our luminous moon for nighttime. He also made the twinkly stars shine with the moon at night. On the fifth day, God filled the oceans with all kinds of fish and whales, sharks and eels, and He filled the sky and trees with many kinds of colorful, chirping birds. On the sixth day, God filled the land with all sorts of amazing animals, like growling tigers, wiggly monkeys, fast wolves, and fluffy rabbits. He also created two people: Adam and Eve. On the seventh day, God looked at all He had made. He thought it was so good! God was happy with all His work, and He rested on the seventh day.

Genesis 2

God creates Adam and Eve and then rests. When God finished working on the rest of His creation, He formed the shape of a man with the sand on the ground. God breathed His own breath into the shape of the man, and the man became a living being! God showed the man, named Adam, all He had made. God placed Adam in a garden He planted called Eden. It was a wonderful garden with lots of plants Adam could enjoy. Four big rivers flowed through the garden and watered the plants and trees. God told Adam to tend the garden and take care of it. God also said that Adam could eat from any of the trees in the garden, except for one. God said not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil because if he did, he would die. Then God brought all the animals to Adam for him to see. God let Adam name all the animals, like hippopotamuses, giraffes, sloths, jaguars, and rhinoceroses! BIBLE STORY



Genesis 12:1-9

God calls Abram to leave his country and promises blessing. Do you know what a blessing is? A blessing is when God promises good things for your life! Abram was a person to whom God gave a special blessing. God asked Abram to do something hard. God asked Abram to leave his home, neighborhood, and some of his family. God told Abram that God would make him a great nation and that Abram's name would always be remembered! That made Abram happy because he was 75 years old and had no children yet. He wanted children very badly. God also said that all people on Earth would be blessed through Abram! That means good things would happen to them because of Abram. Abram believed in God's blessing! So, Abram packed up all his stuff, such as his clothes, his animals, his workers, and his belongings. He brought his wife Sarai with him and his nephew, Lot. They left and went toward a land called Canaan. When they arrived in Canaan, God appeared to Abram and told him that the land he was standing on would someday belong to his children! Abram was so happy to be so blessed by God that he built an altar. An altar was a special place, often made with stones, where Abram could offer a gift to give thanks for what God has done or said in that place. The gift would be something good to eat, like beef or lamb. Abram wanted to always remember the blessing and promises that God had made to him!

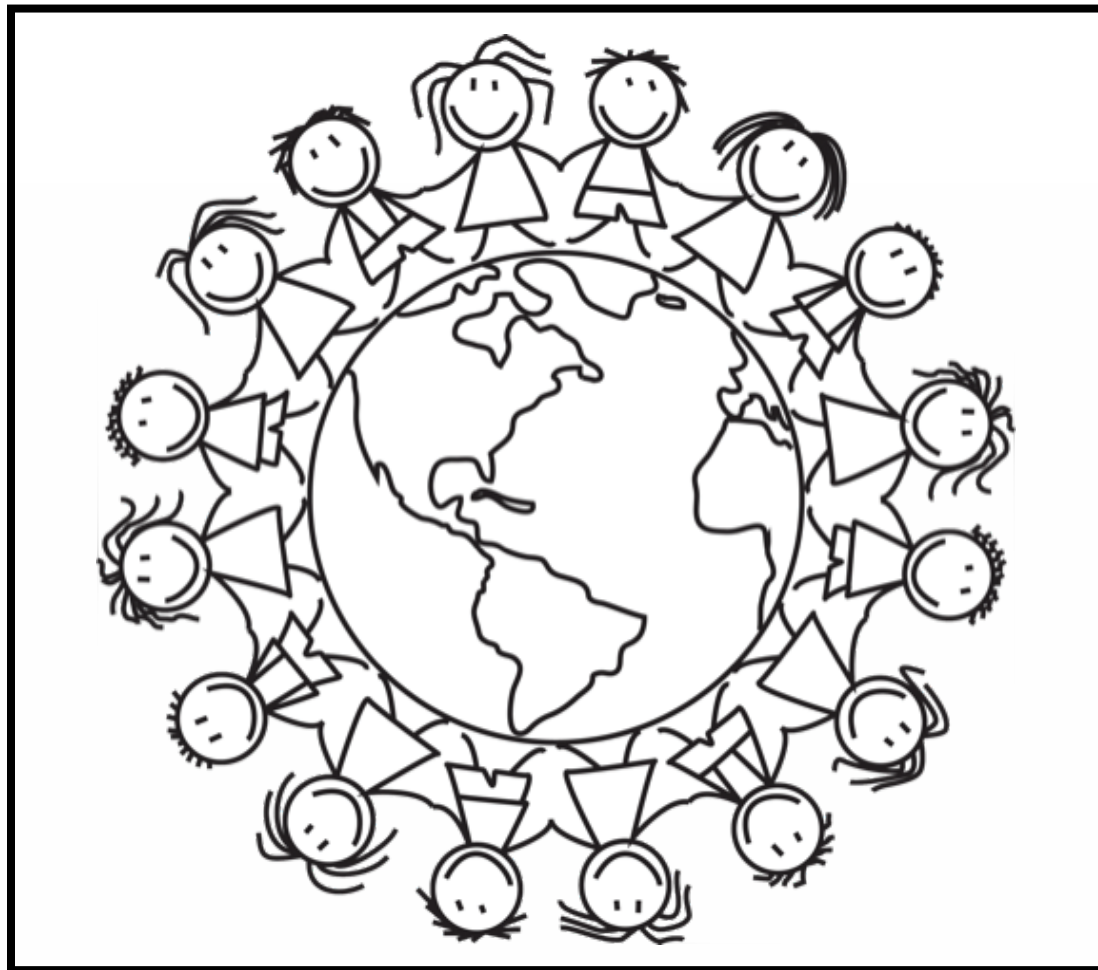

Genesis 14

Abram rescues Lot from four kings. Abram and Lot traveled for a while and found places to live. Lot lived in a city called Sodom. Unfortunately, the king of Sodom was a bad king. He didn't want to serve another king anymore or pay him money like he had agreed to. So, he and four other kings rebelled against the king over them. That king wanted to stop them from rebelling. So, he came with three other kings and attacked the five kings that rebelled. The rebellious kings fled with their armies, leaving the city of Sodom unprotected. The king that attacked captured the people and goods left in the city. They also captured Lot and Lot's stuff! One of the people from Sodom who escaped came to see Abram. He told Abram about Lot being captured. Abram knew that God would help him to save Lot and his family. Abram called all his workers, 318 men, to help him go and rescue Lot. They found the army and attacked it at night! Abram and his men were able to free Lot and the rest of the captives. They also got back all the stuff the four kings had taken! A holy king who was also a priest of God's, Melchizedek, came to Abram after he had saved Lot. He said that God had blessed Abram and had delivered Abram from his enemies! The king of Sodom wanted to pay Abram for saving the people and stuff. But Abram said no. He wanted to show that his blessings came from God, not from a bad king like the king of Sodom.
