

Core Bible Story

Mark 1:40-45 Jesus Heals a Man with Leprosy

Bible Passage 1 Colossians 1:16b-17

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 3

Fall Encounter: YOU GOT IT ALL — Adventures in the Mission of God's Son

Overview

FALL Core Bible Stories feature the miracles of Jesus from Mark's gospel, with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as John 3:16 ("For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son") and John 14:6 ("I am the way and the truth and the life") in the application of the mission of God's Son.

Targets

By the end of Grade 3 FALL, students will be able to accomplish the following 30 spiritual responses:

- 1. Realize that Jesus came from the Father to save us from our sins.
- 2. Recognize that Jesus is more than a superhero and holds all of creation together.
- 3. Praise Jesus that He existed as God's Son before anything was created.
- 4. Acknowledge that an attitude of gratitude is being thankful for what Jesus did.
- 5. Recognize that our attitude should be to love each other as Jesus loved us.
- 6. Thank God who could have spared His Son from death but chose to save us instead.
- 7. Appreciate that God was willing to give us His Son and will also give us all things.
- 8. Live knowing that the God of Moses and Joseph is the same God we can trust today.
- 9. Know that God reminds us of the heroes of the Bible, who depended on their faith.
- 10. Remember that God used His power to overcome the weakness of ordinary men.
- 11. Realize that God loved us so much that He gave us His only Son.
- 12. Praise God that He saved the day when He made a way for our sins to be forgiven.
- 13. Trust that God provided forgiveness at the cross through His Son Jesus.
- 14. Express joy and confidence in being saved by God's grace through faith in Jesus.
- 15. Acknowledge that no one can boast about getting to heaven since it's a gift from God.
- 16. Remember that no matter where we find ourselves, God is right there with us.
- 17. Express thanks to God, who promises to hold us with His right hand.
- 18. Remember that Jesus wants us to spread His Word to not only our own town but to the world.
- 19. Recognize that Jesus told His disciples that they would receive power from the Holy Spirit.
- 20. Choose to be a disciple of Christ and spread the truth about His death and resurrection.
- 21. Remember that God heard Jonah's prayer and gave him a second chance to obey.
- 22. Trust that when we obey God, He helps us to accomplish great things through Him.
- 23. Acknowledge that Jesus holds the key to eternal life and is the only way to the Father.
- 24. Identify Jesus as proof that God not only exists but that He also sent Jesus to forgive our sins.
- 25. Fully realize that Jesus said, "No one comes to the Father except through Me."
- 26. Daily remember that training to be Godly brings rewards for today and for eternity.
- 27. Realize that man admires the outside, but God cherishes the heart.
- 28. Remember that becoming more Godly takes effort and the desire to pursue God.
- 29. Express joy in knowing that God rewards those who earnestly seek Him.
- 30. Identify that having faith requires coming to God and believing that He exists.

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 3

Spring Encounter: SOUL SURFIN' — Adventures in the Spread of God's Message

Overview

Spring Core Bible Stories feature the world-changing events of Acts, with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as John 20:31 ("By believing you may have life in his name") and Acts 4:12 ("There is no other name by which we must be saved") in the application of the spread of God's message.

Targets

By the end of Grade 3 SPRING, students will be able to accomplish the following 30 spiritual responses:

- 1. Recognize that in the book of Acts, Paul's habit was to share God's Word with non-believers.
- 2. Understand that Paul reasoned with the people in the Synagogue from the Scriptures.
- 3. Grasp that Paul explained it very simply: the Christ had to suffer and rise from the dead.
- 4. Praise God that the miracles of Jesus were written so we would know He is God's Son.
- 5. Recognize the challenge Jesus gave in that we are blessed when we believe without seeing.
- 6. Recall that Peter and John were actual eyewitnesses of Jesus, having seen and heard Him in person.
- 7. Imitate that Peter and John could not stop speaking about what they had seen and heard.
- 8. Remember that the subject God wants us to speak boldly about is our faith in Christ.
- 9. Acknowledge and proclaim that eternal life can truly be found in Jesus' name only.
- 10. Recognize that we must be saved (rescued) from our sins to enter into heaven.
- 11. Praise God that He sent His Son to demonstrate His own love while we were without a Savior.
- 12. Recognize that the most important promise in this world is eternal life through Jesus Christ.
- 13. Trust that the birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus was part of God's plan.
- 14. Put your hope in God knowing that man has clever strategies, but God has perfect plans.
- 15. Express joy over God declaring that He has plans to give His people a hope and a future.
- 16. Remember that confessing with your mouth means agreeing with God that Jesus is Lord.
- 17. Appreciate that God raised Jesus from the dead to save mankind from their sins.
- 18. Share with others the reward of knowing we've been saved through faith by the grace of God.
- 19. Communicate to friends that the treasure of God's Word is salvation through faith in Christ.
- 20. Celebrate that God designed the Holy Scriptures to make us wise for salvation.
- 21. Express thanks to God for designing us to hear and know Him when He calls.
- 22. Acknowledge that God created us and does not live in temples built by human hands.
- 23. Praise God that He Himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else.
- 24. Remember that anyone can repent (turn around) and decide to believe in God.
- 25. Be assured that though much of the world ignores God, He is patient with us and loves us.
- 26. Identify that the origin of the Bible is clear: It's not the word of men, but actually the Word of God.
- 27. Daily depend on the Bible as both the Old and New Testaments tell the story of our need for Jesus.
- 28. Recognize that God wants us to accept the message of the Holy Bible as the Word of God.
- 29. Live with hope and joy knowing that Christ followers will talk face-to-face in heaven.
- 30. Be encouraged that believers in Christ have a bond with each other through the love of Christ.
