Core Bible Story

Judges 7:1–14 Gideon Defeats the Midianites

Bible Passage 1

Ephesians 6:10–11 

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.

Bible Passage 2

Philippians 3:13b–14

Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 5

Fall Encounter: **GAME FACE** — Adventures in the Display of God's Supremacy

Overview

FALL Core Bible Stories feature victorious heroes of the Old Testament, with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as Ephesians 6:10-11 ("Put on the full armor of God") and Hebrews 4:12 ("The Word of God is living and active") in the application of the display of God's supremacy.

Targets

By the end of Grade 5 FALL, students will be able to accomplish the following 30 spiritual responses:

1. Be confident knowing that God's armor helps us take a stand against the temptations of the evil one.
2. Put on God's spiritual armor daily by letting faith, truth and righteousness rule in our lives.
3. Realize that there is a spiritual battle in which Satan uses schemes to defeat us.
4. Strain toward what is ahead by forgetting what is behind and keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus Christ.
5. Imitate Paul by pushing toward the finish to reach our goal and be in the presence of Jesus.
6. Remember that David knew the score: God had already delivered him from a lion and a bear.
7. Acknowledge that David faced Goliath with one weapon: the name of the Lord God Almighty.
8. Remember to let God take on our biggest challenges since no battle is too big for Him.
9. Praise God that nothing can separate us from His massive love that came through Christ Jesus our Lord.
10. Trust that not even death, life, angels, demons, powers, depth or height can separate us from God's love.
11. Follow the example that even though Joseph was treated unfairly, he never stopped trusting God.
12. Face tough challenges knowing that God works for the good of those who love Him.
13. Have faith in God knowing it was He who sent Joseph to Egypt, not his brothers with their evil plan.
14. Humbly confess our sins to God to be cleansed and to put Him on the throne of our life.
15. Acknowledge that God is faithful and always leaves the door open for His forgiveness.
16. Throw off the sin that so easily entangles us and run toward the love of the Son of God.
17. Live the Christian life with perseverance by fixing our eyes on Jesus and enduring as He did.
18. Remember that Jesus is the author and perfecter of our faith as we grow to trust Him more.
19. Recognize that the peace of Christ is not from this world, but rather from heaven.
20. Have hope in God knowing that though the world brings trouble, Jesus overcame sin and death.
21. Realize that The Bible is living because it is God's Word, and active because it speaks to our hearts.
22. Acknowledge that God's Word is powerful and judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
23. Seek the Bible as the living Word of God, knowing it can penetrate our soul and spirit and speak to us.
24. Remember that God doesn't find fault in us when we ask Him for wisdom, but rather gives it generously.
25. Realize that when we ask for wisdom, we must believe and not doubt in order to receive it.
26. Take comfort knowing that Jesus was tempted as a man in every way and understands our weaknesses.
27. Recall with confidence that God cares for us and promises grace and mercy in our time of need.
28. Remember daily that we can go near to the throne with confidence and pray to God at any time.
29. Know that though man brought sin into the world, God sent Jesus into the world with eternal life.
30. Praise God that His love overflowed to the many and overcame the penalty of sin through Christ.

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 5

Spring Encounter: GOD CITY — Adventures in the Gift of God's Kingdom

Overview

SPRING Core Bible Stories feature the promises of eternity in John's gospel, with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as 1 Corinthians 2:9 ("No eye has seen what God has prepared") and John 4:13-14 ("Whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst") in the application of the gift of God's kingdom.

Targets

By the end of Grade 5 SPRING, students will be able to accomplish the following 30 spiritual responses:

1. Rejoice in knowing that one day God will live among us and wipe every tear from our eyes.
2. Take comfort knowing that the old order of things will pass away to the newness of heaven.
3. Marvel at the fact that we will not experience death, mourning, crying or pain in heaven.
4. Acknowledge that God is feared and praised, for no one in the skies above is like the Lord.
5. Praise God knowing that He is immeasurably more awesome than all who surround Him.
6. Realize that the works of God's hands tell of His existence and demonstrate His handiwork.
7. Delight that God's glory is on display for every eye to see as He speaks to man through His creation.
8. Praise God that in His great mercy, He gave us new birth through the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
9. Celebrate that eternal life is kept in heaven for believers and can never perish, spoil or fade.
10. Face every day knowing that the gift of eternal life is a living hope for all who belong to Christ.
11. Acknowledge that Jesus gives us a rush of living water, which is faith welling up to eternal life.
12. Fully realize that eternal life flows only one way: through the gift of faith in Jesus Christ.
13. The ultimate display of love was God offering forgiveness through the sacrifice of His only Son.
14. Understand that God sent Jesus as an atonement: to set us free from the punishment of sin.
15. Recognize that the gift of eternal life through Jesus is the result of God loving us, not us loving Him.
16. Remember daily to live by faith—not by sight—as we set our sights on Jesus to live this life for Him.
17. Realize that although we would prefer to be at home with the Lord, we live now to please Him here.
18. Trust the Lord for faith, which is being sure of the unseen and what God's Word says to be true.
19. Live with joyful hope knowing that God has prepared the unimaginable for His children.
20. Thank God that He has prepared what no one has seen, heard or imagined for those who love Him.
21. Daily choose to follow Jesus by denying ourselves and surrendering our choices and actions to Him.
22. Boldly proclaim that to live apart from Jesus Christ is to ignore God and deny the Savior of the world.
23. Rejoice that believers in Christ will overcome the penalty of sin and have entrance into the Holy City.
24. Take heart trusting that Jesus said, "Behold I am coming soon, and my reward is with Me."
25. Live with joy knowing that believers will run from the gates of the Holy City to the throne of God.
26. Realize that our permanent citizenship is in heaven, from which we eagerly await our Savior's arrival.
27. Praise God that the bodies of Christ followers will be transformed into glorious bodies like His.
28. Acknowledge that Jesus has the power to bring everything in heaven and on earth under His control.
29. Live with anticipation knowing that believers will experience God's brilliance as they never imagined it.
30. Delight in knowing that the source of light in heaven will be the full display of the glory of God.
