




Genesis I God creates the world.

Direct the students to color the pictures while they hear the Bible Story and trace the letters of the two words.








Genesis 2 God creates man.

When God finished working on the rest of His creation, He formed the shape of a man with the dust on the ground. God breathed His own breath into the shape of the man, and the man became a living being! God placed Adam in a garden He planted called Eden, where four big rivers flowed and watered the plants and trees. God told Adam to tend the garden and take care of it. God also said that Adam could eat from any of the trees in the garden, except for one. God said not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil because if he did, he would die.

Then, God brought all the animals to Adam for him to see. God let Adam name all the animals, like jaguars, and giraffes! God saw Adam and thought, "It is not good for the man to be alone." LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 2, God blesses the seventh day as holy and rests after His work of creation. God forms man from the dust and gives Adam the breath of life. He places him in the Garden of Eden, which holds the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. God commands Adam not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. He creates for Adam a suitable helper from his rib: woman.





Genesis 3 Adam and Eve disobey God.

In the beautiful garden that God created for Adam and Eve, a tricky serpent asked Eve if God really said they could not eat from the tree in the middle of the garden. Eve told him that if they ate from that tree, they would die. The serpent said that if they ate from that tree, they would be as smart as God. Eve believed the serpent and ate the fruit, and then gave some to Adam. Afterward, they felt ashamed for disobeying God. They covered their bodies with leaves and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden when they heard Him walking.

God called out to Adam and Eve, "Where are you?" Adam said he was afraid because he was naked and so he hid, so God asked if they had eaten the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden. Adam said Eve gave him some fruit and he ate it. Eve said the serpent tricked her and she ate it. Then God turned to the serpent and cursed it so it would crawl on its belly and eat dirt from then on. God then told Adam and Eve that living and working to feed their family outside of the garden would be painful work, and that they would not live forever. Then God sent Adam and Eve out of the garden.

BIBLE STORY MEMORY Genesis 3:8

They hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden.



LESSON SETTING: God tells Adam and Eve to eat of any plant they wish but one. That tree's fruit brings death. But a serpent tells Eve that God lied. He claims the fruit brings wisdom, not death. So Adam and Eve eat. Consequently, God says they will indeed die. But one day Eve's descendant will crush the serpent (Genesis 3:15). Graciously, God makes Eve able to create life through painful childbirth and Adam able to sustain life through painful toil.





After reviewing the Bible Story, direct the students to color the picture of the forbidden tree where the tricky serpent told Eve it was okay to disobey God.





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



LESSON

Genesis 12, 14 God calls & empowers Abram.

God gave Abram a special blessing with promises of good things for his life. God then asked Abram to do something hard and leave his home and some of his family. God told Abram He would make him a great nation and that all people on Earth would be blessed through him! So, Abram believed God, packed up all his belongings, and brought with him his wife Sarai and his nephew, Lot. In a land called Canaan, God told Abram that the land he was standing on would someday belong to his children! Abram was so happy that he built an altar made of stones and rocks to give thanks for what God had done.

Lot then lived in a city called Sodom. Their bad king and four kings ran away after being attacked by four other kings, leaving the city unprotected. Lot and all he owned were captured, but one of the people from Sodom escaped and told Abram. Abram knew God would help him to rescue Lot and called 318 men to help. They attacked the enemy's army at night and were able to free Lot and all the captives! The king of Sodom wanted to pay Abram for saving them, but Abram said no to show that his blessings come only from God.



BIBLE STORY MEMORY Genesis 12:2

LESSON SETTING: In Genesis 12 and 14, God calls Abram to leave his homeland. He promises to make a great nation from his descendants and bless all the families of the earth. Abram and his family leave Ur and sojourn in the land of Canaan. Then, God demonstrates His power to protect His people when Abram's nephew Lot, who lives in Sodom, is captured during a battle. Sodom's king and four other kings rebel against King Kedorlaomer, who with three other kings attack and capture many! But one escapes and informs Abram, who assembles his 318 trained men to strike back. With God's help, he brings back Lot, the rest of the captives, and the stolen goods.


