UNIT TEACHER PREP

Lamentations 3:22-23 Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

BIBIF SUMMARY

In the Adventures in the Calling of God's Champions, God creates Adam and Eve to be champions who fill the earth with people who bear His image and rule the earth. However, they disobey God. As a result, their descendants fill the earth with corruption. But God's plan remains.

LESSON 1 THE FALL (GENESIS 3)

LESSON TARGET: Learn how Adam and Eve sin against God.

LESSON SETTING: God tells Adam and Eve to eat of any plant they wish but one. That tree's fruit brings death. But a serpent tells Eve that God lied. He claims the fruit brings wisdom, not death. So Adam and Eve eat. Consequently, God says they will indeed die. But one day Eve's descendant will crush the serpent (Genesis 3:15). Graciously, God makes Eve able to create life through painful childbirth and Adam able to sustain life through painful toil.

LESSON 2 THE COMMAND (GENESIS 6)

LESSON TARGET: Understand why God commands Noah to build an ark.

LESSON SETTING: Satan deceived Eve through the serpent and became ruler of the earth (Luke 4:6; John 12:31; Ephesians 2:2). As Adam and Eve's descendants drift farther from God, they become violent and corrupt, filling the earth with people whose every inner thought is evil (Genesis 6:5). God plans to wash the earth of corruption. As part of that plan, He calls the righteous man Noah to build an ark to hold his family, animals, and food.

LESSON 3 THE FLOOD (GENESIS 7)


LESSON TARGET: Understand that God floods the earth because people become evil.

LESSON SETTING: After Noah, his family, and the animals enter the ark, rain comes. It rains for 40 days and 40 nights. The floodwaters wash corruption from the earth. Therefore, God's promise to Eve of a descendant who will defeat the serpent will come through Noah. Additionally, God shortens human lives, thereby limiting the amount of evil any one person can do to another, and limiting the amount of suffering any one person must endure (Genesis 6:3).

LESSON 4 THE COVENANT (GENESIS 8)

LESSON TARGET: Learn the promise God makes to His creation.

LESSON SETTING: When the waters finally recede, Noah's family and the animals exit the ark. Afterward, God makes a covenant with all living creatures to never again destroy the earth with water. The sign of the covenant is the rainbow. God tells Noah's family the same thing He told Adam and Eve: fill the earth with people.







Genesis 3 Adam and Eve sin against God.

Adam and Eve lived in a garden that God created for them. One day a bad serpent asked Eve if God really said they could not eat from any tree in the garden. Eve told him they could eat from any tree but the one in the middle, which was the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. God said that if they ate from that tree, they would die. The serpent said that they would not die, but rather be like God, knowing good and evil Eve believed the serpent and ate the fruit so she could be like God. Then she gave some to Adam and he ate it too.






Genesis 7 God floods the earth.
