

Bible REPLAY Curriculum Grade 1

UNITS 5-8: FEARLESS FRONTIER — Adventures in the Advance of God's Son

Overview

UNITS 5-8 Core Bible Stories feature God's power through Samson and Nehemiah, the baptism, temptation and teachings of Jesus, and the "Romans Road" of salvation—with correlating Unit Bible Passages and songs such as Isaiah 41:10 ("Do not fear, for I am with you") and John 11:25-26 ("I am the resurrection and the life").

Targets

By the end of Grade 1 UNITS 5-8, students will accomplish the following 25 spiritual responses:

1. Believe that God promises to be with us whenever we are afraid.
2. Confess that we get dismayed or worried when we forget who God is.
3. Never forget that God's desire is to strengthen us and to help us.
4. Praise God that He promises to protect us with His righteous right hand.
5. Acknowledge that God's wisdom is worth more than any treasure.
6. Remember that God in us is greater than God's enemy in the world.
7. Thank God for sending Jesus, the one within us, to conquer our sin.
8. Be encouraged that God's children are from God and dear to Him.
9. Recognize that Jesus used God's Word to defeat the devil's temptation.
10. Celebrate the fact that God celebrates when one sinner turns to Him.
11. Marvel that God will never stop searching for sinners to receive His love.
12. Rejoice that Jesus does God's Work to teach and heal no matter the day.
13. Know that Jesus said whoever believes in Him will live, even though he dies.
14. Rejoice with the knowledge that believers in Christ have new life in Him.
15. Believe that Jesus was resurrected and lives in the hearts of believers.
16. Appreciate that Jesus waits with open arms for unbelievers to find Him.
17. Jesus conquered sin and death on the cross to give us eternal life.
18. Be encouraged that God will never give up on lost people who deny Him.
19. Admit that all of us have sinned and fall short of (long for) God's glory.
20. Realize that the cross of Christ spared man of eternal separation from God.
21. Have no doubt that God loves us and wants us to be with him forever.
22. Praise God for His love since Christ died for us while we were still sinners.
23. Celebrate that God gave us the gift of eternal life through Jesus our Lord.
24. Recognize that it is by God's grace that we are saved, not by our efforts.
25. Know that salvation comes through faith in Jesus' death and resurrection.
